The result is a dynamic, colourful, joyful and child-centric workplace that uplifts the spirit immediately upon arrival. Bespoke graphics further reinforce the intent.

A key feature to this is a large 100 person timber clad auditorium space cut through the existing building's centre. This provides a dynamic focal point for presentations, reflection and larger gatherings, as well as being equipped with a dynamic audio visual system. Further facilities include co-joined meeting rooms, study spaces, meeting pods, a wellness space, kitchen and outdoor decked terrace.
